Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social security number and income; Transactions and transaction history; and Credit history and account balances. 	
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. WHAT WE DO		
How does The Bullion Advisory Group, LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does The Bullion Advisory Group, LLC collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or become a Client • Seek credit or make transactions; and/or • Make any material change or changes to your existing relationship with The Bullion Advisory Group, LLC • We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness; • Affiliates from using your information to market to you; and • Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.	
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account – unless you tell us otherwise.	

DEFINITIONS	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. The Bullion Advisory Group LLC does not share with non-affiliated companies so they can market their products to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. We only share information with non-Bullion Advisory Group affiliated companies to service transactions that you request.
